Fit and Proper Person Requirement Declaration

A person seeking or holding the status of a Registered Recreation Professional on NZRRP must be, and remain during the period of registration, a fit and proper person.

To maintain this standard NZRRP Governance Group requires each Registered Individual to:

- 1. Be physically and emotionally fit; and
- 2. be ethical and behave in an appropriate way, and
- 3. be mindful of their influence on safety, and
- 4. not bring NZRRP or the standards it administers into disrepute, and
- 5. be able to read, understand and query technical information related to the role they are appointed to, and
- 6. be legally permitted to work in New Zealand.

Individuals applying for registration will need to agree to:

- 1. being in a suitable physical and emotional condition to carry out the professional services; and
- 2. work to the Code of Ethical Practice for Recreation Professionals; and
- 3. have no undisclosed history of fraud, dishonesty, behavioural issues that would cause doubt over their fitness or ability to act in this role; and
- 4. have the literacy and numeracy skills to fulfil this role; and
- 5. are legally able to work in New Zealand

An attestation from a respected industry member as to the accuracy of this declaration will also be required.
